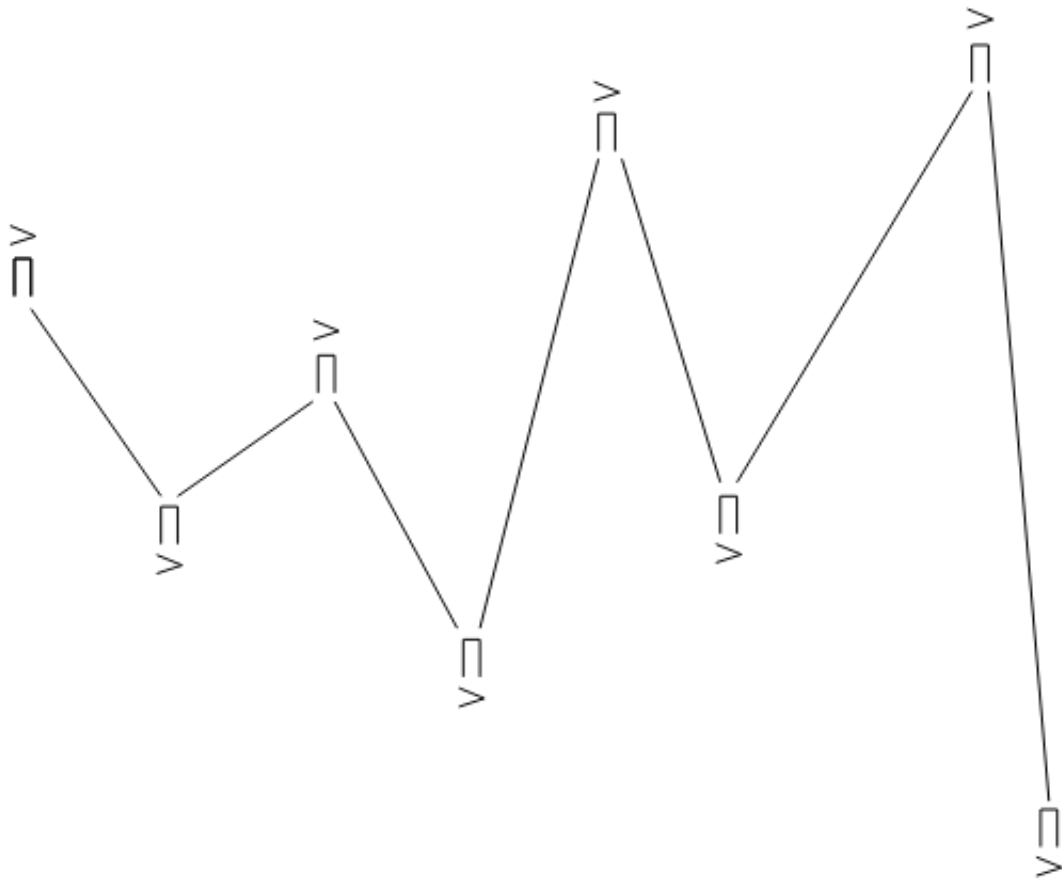

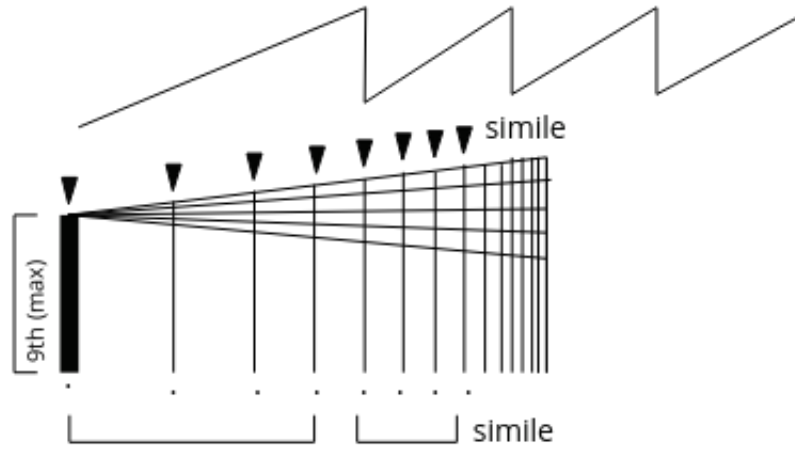


$\begin{matrix} \vee \\ \sqcup \end{matrix}$ = two identical pitches played in a very fast succession with one hand, but two different fingers with an accent on the first note.

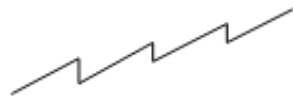
———— = The lines indicate the order of notes and register spacing, while horizontal proportionality dictates the tempo.

*The order of accents can be reversed

| = either complete, or an incomplete cluster played with both hands. Each hand only plays a set of 3-4 pitches, but also of the opposite kind in relation to the other hand.



= playing cluster chords (4) in ascending fashion, while gradually speeding up, before coming down to play the next group of four chords.
